By assuming the role of an employee in each targeted career, students tackle typical tasks found in a day's work. ***Learning About Careers*** is ideal for Career Discovery and Career Exploration courses.

Each lesson includes:

- A career overview in which students identify the skills, knowledge, and characteristics required to achieve success
- Typical academic, customer service, and other tasks an employee might perform on the job (applied academics skills)
- A personal budget exercise based on expected career earnings in that field
- Additional resources for further exploration

Students will be able to make preliminary decisions about careers while improving their work readiness and academic skills.
